GENERAL MEMBERS' MEETING AT HYDERABAD

A meeting of general members of AIBOC, A.P. State Committee was held on 16th August, 2013 at Parvana Hall, Prabhat Towers, Hyderabad. The meeting was organized by the A.P. state committee of AIBOC at a very short notice to coincide with the visit of Com. Harvinder Singh, the newly elected General Secretary of AIBOC for some organizational work.

Short notice and inclement weather could not deter the members from attending the meeting. The hall was full to its capacity as more than 400 members from various affiliates of AIBOC reached to listen to the leaders of the apex organization. The hall was reverberating with the spirit matching with the name of the venue kept after the names of great legendary trade union leaders of the banking industry, viz. Late Com. H.L. Parvana and Late Com. Prabhatkar.

Com. (Dr.) Rajagopala Reddy (Indian Bank), the President and Com. P. Anandha Kumar (Allahabad Bank) State Secretary of A.P. State committee of AIBOC shared the dais with Com. Harshvardhan Madhabhushi & Com. Harvinder Singh. Com. (Dr.) Rajagopala Reddy welcomed the members and apprised about co-option of Com. Harshvardhan M. and Com Harvinder Singh as President and General Secretary of AIBOC, respectively, in the EC meeting of AIBOC held on 28th June, 2013 at Kolkata. He advised the members about the reconstitution of A.P. State Committee of AIBOC, with Com. P. Anandha Kumar and himself as President and General Secretary, respectively, due to elevation of Com. Harshvardhan M. to the post of President of AIBOC. Com. P.V. Singa Reddy (PNB), President and Com. N.Satyanarayana (Andhra Bank) General Secretary of State Unit of AINBOF were also present in the meeting along with leaders of AIBPARC.

The President and the State Secretaries of A.P. State Committee of both AIBOC and AINBOF felicitated Com Harshvardhan M. and Com. Harvinder Singh with bouquet and shawl. Com. Rajagopala Reddy expressed that it is a proud privilege for the A.P. state members that both the leaders are available together, for the first time ever since their co-option, to address them. He urged all the members to participate in the proposed Dharna and Rally on 25th September, 2013 to make it successful.

The members were also briefed in detail about developments in salary revision that took place in the meeting held on 12th August 2013, when the negotiating Committee met at Mumbai. He assured the members that he shall endeavour to do full justice to the responsibilities thrust upon him and shall leave no stone unturned in working for the benefit of the general members and achieving the common goal and objectives of the confederation. He sought help of all in strengthening the hands of the confederation by display of unity.

The President Com. Harshvardhan while addressing the gathering referred to the Independence day celebrations across the country and asked all those present to introspect whether the common masses of the country are actually enjoying the freedom in its true sense as envisaged in the address of our Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru on the eve of our Independence. He narrated socio economic problems faced by the country adversely affecting the common people. While referring to the National Convention of Labour held at Delhi, he appealed to all to make the action programme complete success by rallying behind the social cause and objectives and requested to strengthen the movement by staying united and responding to the call of the organization.
