10th TRIENNIAL CONFERENCE OF AIBOC

The detailed account of the Inaugural Session of 10th Triennial Conference of AIBOC held on 8th March, 2014 has already been circulated to all the members.

The Business Session held on 9th & 10th March 2014 was conducted very smoothly and effectively. The auditorium was brimming with nearly 1200 delegates, having come from the length and breadth of the Country, for active participation. As many as 67 delegates came to the dais for expressing their views and seeking information on various issues concerning the banking industry, its officers and staff, trade Union Movement/ policies of RBI & Government/ problems of common man. The deliberation lasted for almost 6-7 hours. The replies to all queries/issues were given in a very crisp, concise and lucid manner by the General Secretary, Com. Harvinder Singh. All present were spell bound and listened with rapt attention. The members got enlivened and enriched by getting clear perspective on all the issues raised, by him.

The business session of the Triennial Conference concluded with election of a new team of office bearers for the term 2014-2017.

We feel happy and proud that Com. Harvinder Singh – The General Secretary of our Federation was the only choice for the post of General Secretary and was elected unopposed amongst thunderous applause. The unique recognition of our Federation is not something new as we have rich legacy of past leaders like Com. S.R. Sengupta who was the founding President and led the Confederation for approximately 16 years as its President and General Secretary. Then after a gap of six years Com. V. Eswaran, earlier General Secretary of our Federation, once again led the organization as its President from 01/06/2007 till 31/05/2009. Com. Harvinder Singh, after having adorned various posts in the Confederation, was co-opted unanimously as its General Secretary on 28th June, 2013 in the ECM of Confederation held at Kolkata in view of the resignation by Com. Rishabadas.
