GOLDEN JUBILEE CELEBRATIONS

At a time when trade union of Bank Officers was unthinkable, the seeds were sown by few militant officers under the leadership of Com. V.M. Devi on 15th December, 1963, at Sardar Baug, Ahmedabad which resulted in the formation of our Federation on 6th November, 1965, at Ahmedabad. When we look back and count the hurdles we have crossed, it fills our hearts with joy and pride. All this could have been made possible because of the valiant struggles and selfless sacrifices of founding fathers of our organisation.

We the members of this great Organisation have the privilege and honour of carrying forward the banner of the Federation which is having hundred percent membership in our Bank.
