
The Conciliation Officer and RLC(C), Mumbai requests and appeals to the AIBOC to call off the proposed strike in the light of the enlightened assurances given by the Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent charge) Labour & Employment, Government of India, New Delhi vide D.O. No. Z-20025/39/2015-Coord dated 30-8-2016 in order to create a conducive atmosphere for keeping the dialogue on towards the resolutions of all the issues.

The Confederation expressed that they apprehensions and concerned on the issues of privatisation of public sector banks, labour law reforms by the Government and FDI in the financial institutions be conveyed to the Management and the Government. The Conciliation Officer & RLC(C), Mumbai assures the Union that the above concerns be carried out to the appropriate forum.




The proceedings are accordingly adjourned to **17-11-2016** at **1530 hrs.**


